Cricket Wales' vision is 'cricket thriving in the heart of Welsh communities'.

Our new strategic plan 'Clearing the Boundaries' was developed in conjunction with the cricket network in Wales and outlines what can be achieved between April 2015 and March 2019. Equality, diversity and inclusion is a key feature of the plan and we are committed to ensuring cricket is more easily accessible for people in Wales.

In 2014 we committed to engaging with insport NGB, a national programme developed by Disability Sport Wales and intended to support National Governing Bodies of Sport to deliver more inclusively. Since then we have been working closely with Disability Sport Wales and the England & Wales Cricket Board to develop more inclusive policies and practices. Examples our work include; the identification of existing pathways and opportunities for disabled players, raising awareness of opportunities for disabled players through community events, providing disability inclusion training for all Cricket Wales staff and ensuring promotional material depicts cricket as an inclusive sport. There is much work to be done but we are committed to achieving the four standards of insport NGB.
